

## TEACHING ASSISTANT POSITIONS AVAILABLE

**1. TUTORIAL LEADER** (Two positions)

**DUTIES:** Tutoring of students in **PHY 100H1F5**

**HOURS OF WORK:** About 28 contact hours plus additional duties which may include preparation, problem and test marking, consultation, term test invigilation, course meetings, final exam marking. Total hours: about 70.

**2. PRACTICALS INSTRUCTOR** (multiple positions)

**DUTIES:** Pairs of Teaching Assistants lead practical groups of up to 36 students through discussion sessions and guided activities involving apparatus for **PHY131H1F5 and PHY132H2S5**.

**HOURS OF WORK:** About 40 contact hours plus additional duties which include regular TA meetings, preparation, office hours, marking and invigilation. Total hours: about 90.

**3. PRACTICALS INSTRUCTOR** (two positions)

**DUTIES:** Teaching Assistants lead group of students through discussion sessions and guided activities involving apparatus for **PHY 205H1S5**.

**HOURS OF WORK:** About 48 contact hours plus additional duties which may include preparation, problem and test marking, consultation, term test invigilation, course meetings, final exam marking. Total hours: about 85.

**DUTIES:** Tutoring of students in **PHY 250H1F5**

**DUTIES:** Tutoring of students in **PHY 254H1S5**

**DUTIES:** Tutoring of students in **PHY 256H1F5**

**HOURS OF WORK:** About 12 contact hours plus additional duties which may include preparation, problem and test marking, consultation, term test invigilation, course meetings, final exam marking. Total hours: about 40 (contingent on enrolment).

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants are expected to have a sound knowledge and proven ability in Physics, as well as good communication skills and adequate command of the English language.
